




## THEME: NO BOUNDARIES WINNER



Reminiscent of the glow and changes of light seen in different times of the day.




## PILBARA LANDSCAPE HIGHLY COMMENDED



This is clever artwork, with a focus on texture and materiality the artist is guiding our eye in different movements across the canvas, well thought about and elegantly put together.




## WORKS ON PAPER WINNER


# 3D ART/SCULPTURE HIGHLY COMMENDED
