

TERMS AND CONDITIONS



- The Dampier Beachside Markets (Markets) are managed by the Dampier Community
 Association (DCA) and are an all-weather event, unless otherwise notified by the DCA
- 2. Morning Markets officially trade from 9:00am to 12 noon
- 3. Evening Markets officially trade from 5:30pm to 8:30pm
- 4. Vehicles are not permitted to be moving on the venue during Market trade times
- 5. Morning Markets bump-in is from 7:00 to 8:30am, with bump-out from 12:15 to 1:30pm
- 6. Evening Markets bump-in is from 3:30 to 5:00pm, with bump-out from 8:45 to 10:00pm
- 7. Vehicles must be removed from the general public area of the venue by 8:30am (morning events) or by 5:00pm (evening events) NO exceptions
- 8. Vehicles are NOT to be driven in the general public area of the venue between 8:30am and 12:15pm (morning events) or between 5:00 and 8:45pm (evening events) NO exceptions
- 9. Stallholders/food vendors and vehicles MUST vacate the venue by 1:30pm (morning events) or by 10:00pm (evening events) NO exceptions
- 10. Stallholders/food vendors must only sell the products stated on the registration form
- 11. Secondhand goods, alcohol, illegal drugs, pornographic material, weapons or aerosol spray paint MUST NOT be sold
- 12. Stallholders/food vendors must keep their stall site clean and remove all rubbish from the venue/grounds stall rubbish must be taken away and NOT placed in the wheelie bins (these are provided for general public use only)
- 13. Marquees must be weighted down or secured (no pegs) NO exceptions
- 14. All power leads and electrical equipment must be tagged by a licensed electrician
- 15. Parking and traffic signs must be obeyed at all times
- 16. Food vendors must comply with the Australian and New Zealand Food Act 1989
- 17. Food vendors must have a current Food Traders Permit from the local council
- 18. Food vendors are responsible for paying any health inspection fees set by the local council
- 19. Food vendors must have one 4.5kg AB(E) dry chemical powder extinguisher as a minimal fire safety requirement
- 20. Any accident, personal injury or damage to the venue/grounds must be reported to the DCA immediately via the DCA Market Stall
- 21. Workers Compensation, OH&S Licenses and Public Liability Insurance are the full responsibility of the stallholder/food vendor
- 22. Any additional fees not stated in these terms and conditions are the full responsibility of the stallholder/food vendor
- 23. The DCA has a NO REFUND policy, however stall registrations can be transferred to another event in the same calendar year, providing the DCA is notified seven (7) days prior to the event originally registered for
- 24. The DCA reserves the right to cancel an event for any reason with stallholders/food vendors duly contacted and given the option to either transfer registration to another event in the same calendar year, or request a refund of registration fees paid for the cancelled event
- 25. The DCA reserves the right to refuse entry to any stallholder/food vendor, and/or request they vacate the venue, should they not comply with all these terms and conditions
- 26. The DCA reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions without any notice
