

2022-2023 President's Report

DAMPIER COMMUNITY HUB

- The DCA has been managing the Dampier Community Hub's community spaces on behalf of the City of Karratha since 2020. This year we were awarded the tender to manage this facility for another 3 years.
- The Hub continues to be a vibrant, busy, community focussed venue in the heart of town. It is the permanent home of the Dampier Art Space, Dampier Playgroup and Dampier School Readiness Progeam. The DCA hosts monthly Seniors' morning teas and weekly exercise classes. We curate a variety of art and social interest exhibitions in the Hub Foyer all year round.
- The Hub averages between 5 to 10 casual hirers a month, with 5 permanent hirers also utilising the facility. Hirers come from a broad range of local organisations, schools, businesses and Govt. agencies.
- The DCA Office is located at the facility, employing three staff:
 - Sharyn Creighton our full-time Office Manager
 - Jo Leo our part-time Admin Officer
 - Dini de Gruchy our part-time Projects Officer
- Income derived from managing the Hub contributes to a more sustainable future for the DCA as an organisation, enabling us to continue to work towards the benefit of the Dampier community and importantly this aligns with the Dampier Community Plan 2021-2025 goal to retain, regain and develop our services & facilities



DAMPIER CARAVAN PARK

- Since 1993, the DCA has managed the Dampier Caravan
 Park as a social enterprise, on behalf of our community,
 enabling us to be more sustainable as an organisation
- The Park opens seasonally between April and October, with an online booking system and volunteer Park Hosts staying on-site.
- After a slow start to the 2023 season, the Park had around 100% occupancy from June until the season's close in mid-October.
- We have a lease for the Park with Rio Tinto (rent, utilities and maintenance of Rio assets are in-kind) with DCA responsible for minor maintenance costs
- Aligns with Dampier Community Plan 2021-2025 goals to:
 - develop our local economy and tourism
 - retain, regain and develop our services & facilities

DAMPIER ART AWARDS

- A popular annual event created in 2010, the Art Awards are open to all local artists residing within the City of Karratha area
- This year's theme was 'Pure', attracting over 100 entries in eight artwork categories, and almost 1700 visitors (in person and online)
- A 4-week Exhibition at the Community Hall was followed by a 4-week Winners Exhibition at the Hub Foyer, and ongoing individual category winners' exhibitions
- A 'Virtual Awards' was available on the DCA website including video, gallery and People's Choice voting
- Event funded by City of Karratha MoU, with local businesses sponsoring category winners' prizes and judge workshops
- Aligns with Dampier Community Plan 2021-2025 goal to:
 - support and provide community projects & events





DAMPIER ART SPACE

- A DCA managed project to support, encourage and engage local artists
- Aims to activate the space at the Dampier Community Hub's Multipurpose Room 2, via drop-in social sessions, workshops (DCA run and external) and skill sharing sessions
- Project funded by the DCA
- Aligns with Dampier Community Plan
 2021-2025 goal to:
 - support and provide community projects
 and events











DAMPIER BEACHSIDE MARKETS

- Established in 2013, the Markets are a popular seasonal monthly event attracting around 1000 visitors
- 7 events are held annually, 4 Sunday morning and 3 Saturday
 Twilight Markets. Stall holder, food vendors and community
 groups can register via the DCA website, enabling us to
 support our community, local and home-based businesses
- 2023 saw the introduction of a 'Tiny Traders' section to encourage our younger entrepreneurs
- DCA continues to partner with local community groups to raise funds and awareness, and to provide a different focus for each event
- Event funded by City of Karratha MoU
- Aligns with Dampier Community Plan 2021-2025 goals:
 - to support and provide community projects & events
 - to develop our local economy and tourism
 - to enhance and celebrate our foreshore & coastal lifestyle





DAMPIER COMMUNITY GARDEN

- Designed around the ethos of 'recycling, reusing, reducing waste, sustainability, water efficiency, with food at its core'
- The Community Garden has continued to grow thanks to the efforts of local volunteers
- Successful workshops & skill share sessions have been held, including regular 'Pick and Prune's
- Halloween and Christmas celebrations are held here
- In 2023 the City nominated the Garden for the 'Tidy Towns' awards
- We have a lease for this land with the City of Karratha
- Project funded by the DCA
- Aligns with Dampier Community Plan 2021-2025 goals to:
 - support and provide community projects & events
 - improve and beautify our town's appearance







DAMPIER PHOTOGRAPHY AWARDS

- Our Photography Awards were introduced in November
 2022, open to anyone residing within the City of Karratha
- The theme was 'A Moment in Time', attracting over 40
 entries in five categories, and over 1200 visitors (online and
 in person)
- The Main Exhibition was open for 9 days at the Community
 Hall, followed by a 2-week Winners Exhib at the Hub Foyer
- A 'Virtual Awards' was available on the DCA website including a gallery and People's Choice voting
- Event funded by DCA, with local businesses sponsoring category winners' prizes
- Aligns with Dampier Community Plan 2021-2025 goal to:
 - support and provide community projects & events



DAMPIER SENIOR SESSIONS

- Over the past few years the DCA has been actively supporting our Senior residents in a variety of ways
- We host a monthly morning tea, providing the venue and catering, and inviting special guests to attend
- Weekly exercise classes are held in the Community Hall
- Ad-hoc events are held throughout the year, such as Senior
 'Create and Connect' art classes and a Christmas Lunch
- Sessions funded by DCA, supporting local businesses to provide catering & PT sessions
- Aligns with Dampier Community Plan 2021-2025 goal
 to provide seniors with access to services and opportunities to enhance their wellbeing and participation in society



DAMPIER SUNSET MOVIES

- Screening since 2013, the Sunset Movies are a popular free family friendly event
- 6 movies are held annually, shown every two months on Hampton Oval's permanent screen
- Provides opportunity for local food vendors
- DCA funds a 'VIP Area' where community nominate worthy local volunteers
- Event funded by City of Karratha MoU
- Aligns with Dampier Community Plan 2021-2025 goals to:
 - support and provide community projects & events
 - develop our local economy and tourism
 - enhance and celebrate our foreshore & coastal lifestyle







DAMPIER VOLUNTEER EVENT

- In 2022 DCA hosted a special event to recognise and celebrate the huge and varied volunteering efforts of local people
- Over 30 Dampier based clubs and groups were invited –
 all relying on volunteers to thrive and survive
- Each group offers something different to our community and contribute to making Dampier such an awesome place to live, work and play in
- Event funded by DCA
- Aligns with Dampier Community Plan 2021-2025 goals to:
 - support and provide community projects & events
 - strengthen our community voice



DAMPIER YOUTH EVENTS

- The DCA hosts a variety of youth-based events throughout the year
- A Junior Dampier Art Awards is held alongside the main Art Awards, with an annual Christmas Art competition in Dec.
- Surprise Screenings are shown at the Community Hall
- The Community Garden becomes the 'Ghastly Garden of Horrors' and the focal point of local Halloween activities
- Each Christmas sees the Community Garden lit up with the Christmas Illumination and a special visit from Santa
- The DCA provides a local delivery service for Santa Letters
- Events funded by DCA
- Aligns with Dampier Community Plan 2021-2025 goals to:
 - support and provide community projects & events
 - provide our children with access to services and opportunities to enhance their wellbeing and participation in society













- DCA advocates on behalf of Dampier's residents on major local issues, such as the City's Dampier Masterplan
- A representative attends community liaison group meetings for Rio Tinto, Woodside and Pilbara Ports Authority
- DCA funded and supported the introduction of early parenting sessions in Dampier (STEP)
- We presented ad-hoc events during the year, such as Memory Lane Movies and the Cancer Council's Biggest Morning Tea
- DCA has equipment for hire and loans our Red
 Dog mascot costume, marquees and outdoor
 PA system to other local groups for free community events

Sustainability – what we need to do to continue to thrive and survive

- Continue to manage the Dampier Community Hub and the Dampier Caravan Park, enabling us to become self-sustaining and to keep providing all our current services, community events, projects and new initiatives
- Continually monitor the operational costs of running the Association
- Maintain 14 committee members, as volunteer hours help reduce expenses

Funding

- We have secured new 3-year contract with the City of Karratha for management of the Dampier Community Hub
- We are grateful to the City as the major sponsor of our established events: Art Awards, Beachside Markets and Sunset Movies
- We are also grateful to Rio Tinto for their in-kind support of the Dampier Caravan Park
- We continue to look for external sponsorship for our events and projects through various local business, big and small

Additional income sources

- Sale of locally produced books and Dampier branded merchandise: number plates, fishing shirts, water bottles, stubby holders
- Sponsorship of specific events and projects via local businesses: Auriga Pilots, Fortescue Metals Group, High Voltage Resources, Iron Mine Contracting, Oceanic Offshore, Mountway Finances, Pilbara News, Pilbara Ports Authority, Reece Plumbing, Rio Tinto-Dampier Salt, SOAK in Dampier, Test & Tag Karratha, and Woodside
